We are replacing our Spring Show with an online version. We look forward to receiving your entries.

How to take part

- Exhibitors take photos of their exhibits and email them to Sue (Sue.Alexander99@btconnect.com) any time before 5pm on Thursday 11 March.
- Our judge reviews the exhibits anonymously. "Best in Class" awarded. No points will be awarded and no points accumulated towards any annual cups.
- Spring Show Gallery on the EHS website will display the exhibits with exhibitor's name, any comments from the judge and "Best in Class" awards during week commencing 15 March.

Rules

1. Exhibits are photographed either in a vase, or in the garden, with the exception of Classes 11, 12 & 13.
2. Exhibits are not judged on the quality of the photograph. The photograph needs to portray the exhibit clearly. It should display the exhibit close up, as if it was on the show bench. For example, take the image in a good light, use a plain background.
3. Exhibits must be grown by the exhibitor. This excludes any blooms bought from a supermarket!
4. Maximum of 3 entries per class from each exhibitor.
5. All entries to be submitted by 5 pm on Thursday 11 March.
6. Each entry to be clearly marked with exhibitor's name and class number.
7. Each exhibitor to have current 2020/21 red membership card. Renewals can be arranged by post or by visiting the Trading Hut prior to Show Date, 13 March.

Spring Show Online Show Schedule

- Class 1 - Snowdrops, any number
- Class 2 - Daffodil, yellow, 1 bloom
- Class 3 - Daffodil, white, 1 bloom
- Class 4 - Daffodil, bi-colour, 1 bloom
- Class 5 - Daffodil, yellow, 3 blooms
- Class 6 - Daffodil, white, 3 blooms
- Class 7 - Daffodil, bi-colour, 3 blooms
- Class 8 - Daffodils arranged for all round effect, minimum 9 blooms
- Class 9 - Cactus, one pot
- Class 10 - Succulent, one pot
- Class 11 - Camellias, 3 blooms floating in dish of water
- Class 12 - Hellebores, 3 blooms floating in dish of water
- Class 13 - Pansies or violas, 3 blooms floating in dish of water
- Class 14 - Tulip, 1 bloom
- Class 15 - Tulip, 3 blooms
- Class 16 - Flowering shrub, 2 stems of same cultivar
